Bipartisan House Humanities Caucus Leaders Back Museum of the American People

WASHINGTON, DC - The Coalition for the National Museum of the American People announced today that both bipartisan co-chairs of the 72-member Congressional Humanities Caucus, Reps. Thomas Petri, R-WI, and David Price, D-NC, have become cosponsors of a resolution backing the proposed museum.

The museum will tell the immigration and migration stories of *every* ethnic, nationality and minority group that became Americans as well as their movements across the nation.

No federal funding is being sought to plan, build or operate the museum. The <u>congressional</u> <u>resolution</u> calls for a temporary commission to study establishment of the museum.
