Bipartisan House Humanities Caucus Leaders Back Museum of the American People

WASHINGTON, DC - The Coalition for the National Museum of the American People announced today that both bipartisan co-chairs of the 72-member Congressional Humanities Caucus, Reps. Thomas Petri, R-WI, and David Price, D-NC, have become cosponsors of a resolution backing the proposed museum.

The museum will tell the immigration and migration stories of every ethnic, nationality and minority group that became Americans as well as their movements across the nation.

No federal funding is being sought to plan, build or operate the museum. The [congressional resolution](#) calls for a temporary commission to study establishment of the museum.
